## ENCOURAGING RESULTS FROM RED LAKE EXTENSION

**Tri Origin Exploration Ltd. (TOE:TSX Venture Exchange)** is pleased to confirm completion of the most recent geophysical work on the Company's Red Lake Extension property near Red Lake, Ontario.

This 2<sup>nd</sup> phase of line cutting and Induced Polarization surveying has provided encouraging results. As previously announced in the October 20 release entitled: "Potential Gold Bearing Anomalies Identified at Red Lake Extension Property", three gold anomalies were identified with soil geochemical and Induced Polarization surveying along a 7 km line through the middle of the property.

This most recent round of testing, totaling nearly 9 km of Induced Polarization geophysical surveying, has further delineated two of the three initial targets. One of these anomalies is now known to extend for up to 1,800 metres bounded on its eastern end by the gold anomaly detected during October soil sampling. Furthermore, the recent surveying has detected new prospective targets at other nearby locations within the one third (or 30 km sq) of the property where exploration has now been conducted.

The next stage of work at the Property will be to focus on the identified anomalies with drilling slated for early in 2004. The Red Lake Extension is located on a previously unexplored continuation of the Red Lake greenstone belt, host to the Goldcorp Red Lake Mine and the Placer Dome Campbell Mine that have a combined total resource of 23.5 million ounces of gold. Results from Tri Origin's preliminary work continue to reinforce management's belief that the Red Lake Extension property is very prospective for gold deposits.
