**SUMMER WORK PROGRAM INITIATED AT NORTH ABITIBI PROJECT,
KIRKLAND LAKE, ONTARIO.**

Tri Origin Exploration Ltd. (TOE:TSX-V) is pleased to announce that its 2008 summer exploration program has begun at the North Abitibi property located 150 km north of Kirkland Lake, Ontario in the Abitibi Greenstone Belt.

The program will consist of prospecting, geological, geochemical and geophysical surveying as well as diamond drilling. A geological and geochemical survey is now being conducted throughout the property at areas containing known gold occurrences and to explore and identify new areas which will require follow-up drilling. An Induced Polarisation (IP) ground geophysical survey will soon be commenced to refine and prioritize targets prior to commencement of a drill program. The drill program is anticipated to commence during late June upon completion of both the geophysical and geochemical surveys and will test the high priority targets identified by the current field work.

Upon commencement of drilling at North Abitibi, surveying crews will be relocated to the Company's RLX project at Red Lake, Ontario to commence exploration programs in preparation for drilling at RLX later in the summer.

The Company has the option to earn an initial 70% interest in the 7080 acre property from Vista Gold Corp. and Rockhaven Resources Ltd. The property is within the north-central portion of the Abitibi Greenstone Belt, one of Canada's most prolific metal-producing regions. This portion of the Belt is host to the Matagami, Selbaie, Joutel and Casa Berardi gold and base metal mining camps in Quebec and the Detour Lake gold mine in Ontario. Previous drilling on the North Abitibi property in the 1980's and 1990's identified a number of gold occurrences, which management believes, through additional successful detailed exploration, may be expanded into significant gold deposits. It is Tri Origin's intention to explore for extensions or repetitions to these occurrences and investigate their potential economic viability.
