NORTH ABITIBI

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Canadian Shield Gold & Base Metal Projects

Sky Lake (gold)

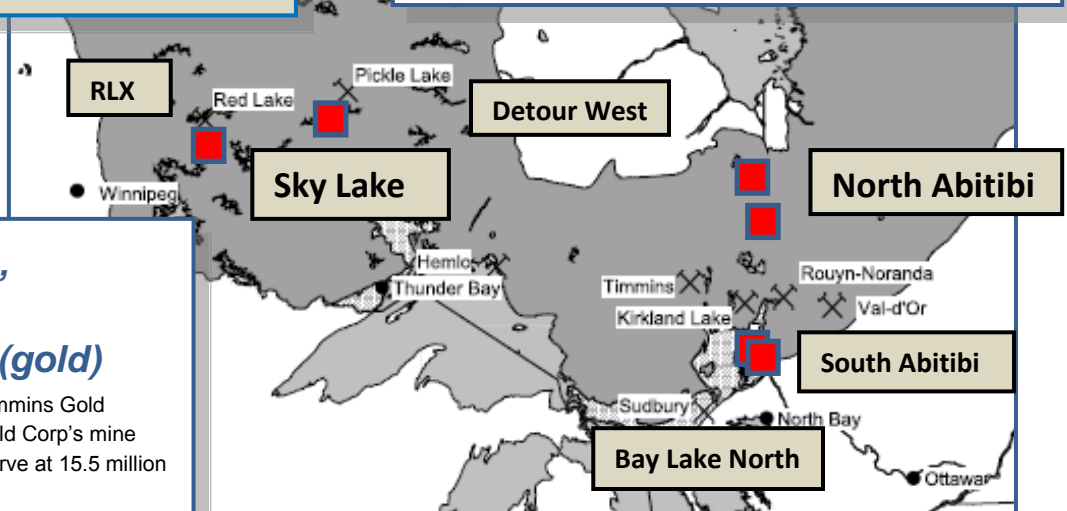
- A 95 km² property located 30 km southwest of the Pickle Lake Gold District with 6 past-producing mines in the belt
- Gold deposits discovered and partially delineated in the 1950's on patent claims optioned from Barrick Gold are targeted for drilling
- New gold occurrences identified by Tri Origin in iron formation & pyritic schists east & west of the deposits indicate potential for district-scale discoveries

Gold deposits partially delineated on patent claims require drilling for resource delineation!

North Abitibi (gold)

- 42 km² property located 150 km north of the Kirkland Lake and Timmins Gold Districts and 40 km west of the producing Casa Berardi Mine in the Abitibi Greenstone Belt, one of the world's most prolific metal-producing regions
- Gold zones have been delineated by drilling for 2 km in strike length but only drilled to 150m in depth with high-grade values returned from surface sampling
- Deep geophysical targeting has outlined strong responses below known gold zones and are drill ready

Drilling planned to evaluate gold zones at depth for their economic potential!



"Projects in the Pipeline"

Detour West (gold), RLX (gold)

- Detour West located 180 km north of the Timmins Gold District is 87 km² contiguous with Detour Gold Corp's mine property- host to Canada's largest gold reserve at 15.5 million ounces
- RLX is a 30 km² property contiguous with Goldcorp's Red Lake mine at Red Lake, Ontario- one of Canada's highest grade gold mines
- Both properties previously unexplored as earlier maps incorrectly indicated that these overburden covered extensions to prolific mining districts were underlain by granites and gneisses
- Preliminary exploration by Tri Origin has identified extensions of gold-bearing structures across both properties
- Detailed targeting to prepare for drilling is required

Previously unrecognized camp-scale discovery potential contiguous to 2 of Canada's premier gold districts!

"Cobalt Area Projects"

South Abitibi (cobalt, gold & base metals), Bay Lake North (cobalt)

- 2 properties total 305 km² -one of the largest landholdings at Cobalt, Ontario
- The underexplored southern margin of the Abitibi Greenstone Belt is mostly covered by younger Proterozoic-age sedimentary rocks
- The covered Abitibi is targeted for a new "Bousquet/LaRonde type" gold/base metal district & the Proterozoic targeted for Cobalt District cobalt/silver deposits
- Gold occurrences in both Proterozoic & Abitibi Belt rocks are widespread at South Abitibi & require continued exploration & drilling
- Cobalt occurrences in the Proterozoic rocks have been identified at Bay Lake & South Abitibi and have not been explored for over 60 years
- Bay Lake North is optioned to MetalsTech Ltd to fund new cobalt exploration
